## **Member Code of Conduct**

Adopted by the Board of Directors on 11/28/2018

The Sugarloaf Mountain Athletic Club strives to provide a welcoming, supportive, enjoyable, and socially safe environment for its members, family members, volunteers, and event participants. To this purpose, members must agree to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Show courtesy toward your fellow club members
- Adhere to the rules of competition and demonstrate exemplary sporting ethics
- Volunteer when possible to support the Club
- Show appreciation for the volunteers and event organizers who give their time to help the Club
- Keep competitiveness to a friendly level
- Support and encourage all members
- Look after the other runners within your training group; if someone is struggling, make sure that they are not left on their own
- While at club events, each member must conduct themselves in such a way as to reflect positively on the Club
- Never harm the natural environment; clean up all trash after events and do not permanently mark, paint, or alter natural objects such as trees or rocks
- Members shall not act in a manner that can be deemed as sexual harassment, which includes unwelcome verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature. Members found to be listed on a sex offender registry may be immediately removed from membership and barred from any and all participation in club activities.
- Report violations of the Member Code of Conduct policy to the Board or to the President in writing
- Members found to be in violation of this Code of Conduct may be removed from membership and participation in events in accordance with the club bylaws
